

# Unit Overview

In order to master the concept of TouchCounting, students must first learn the number and location of each coin's TouchPoints.

## Learning the TouchPoints

The TouchPoints on the nickel, dime, and quarter are introduced. You may also introduce the TouchPoints on the half-dollar during this unit. Students will learn to count the penny last because it does not have any TouchPoints. They will understand that each TouchPoint equals 5 cents and that the line below the penny equals 1 cent. Students will learn to count the TouchPoints on each coin in the correct order (see illustration below). Students will practice TouchCounting series of coins with the TouchPoints already drawn on them.
